- You will be notified prior to April 1, 2020 regarding the continuation or cancellation of these closures. • We will continue to accept EI referrals and conduct intakes over the phone.
- All scheduled IFSP meetings will be conducted via phone conference. • Makeups cannot be done until current closures are cancelled. • You will be paid to date for all related services provided.
- Telehealth, at this time, is not approved for the delivery of EI or Preschool services, which means that you cannot be paid for services provided through this platform. Additionally, if you are keeping in touch with your families using Skype, FaceTime or other instructional platforms, you cannot bill for these events. Please note that there may be other changes, as we receive further guidance from the BEI and the NYSED on providing services to children with disabilities during the COVID-19 outbreak.
