## **Temporary Extension of an IFSP for the 6 Month Review\***

IFSP's being reviewed now through January 31, 2021 can be extended for 6 months without the participation of the EIOD if the following is in place:

1. The 6-month progress reports from all providers are uploaded into NYEIS
2. There are no anticipated changes in duration or frequency of the current services
3. If a supplemental evaluation is requested justification must be made in the progress report
4. The parent agrees with the plan
5. The IFSP meeting is to be held with the parent and OSC to review outcomes, insurance, and transition if applicable

If these conditions are met, after the meeting please:

- Submit the IFSP in NYEIS
- Submit the IFSP signed consent page
- The EIOD will review and approve

Additionally:

After an IFSP Amendment Determination form for a new service or supplemental evaluation is signed by the parent, the OSC can enter the Service Authorization (SA) for the EIOD to approve.

\*Please note: This only applies to 6-month, 18-month and 30-month reviews. The 12-month, 24-month and 36-months reviews continue to require EIOD participation.
